#### **Beginning of the Semester Tips**

1. Get to the bus stop early. AggieSpirit buses will be full the first few weeks, so plan to arrive to your stop extra early to make it to class.
2. Sign up for an account in the [Bus Routes app](#) to receive notifications and important updates to your routes.
3. Use the "[Plan a Trip](#)" feature to plan your route. Ensure you know the bus stop where you'll arrive and any necessary bus transfers to reach your final destination.

# SUSTAINABLE TRANSPORTATION

## Is your student using a bike, scooter, board, or other form of micromobility?

With more than 1,700 racks across campus, it is easy to find and lock to a bike rack. All micromobility must be locked to a bike rack. Any devices locked to handrails, light poles, benches, trees, anything other than a bike rack, will be booted or impounded. Those in violation will be responsible for pick up and/or lock replacement at their expense.



# PARKING

## Is your student planning to park on campus?

Before the semester starts, make sure your students are familiar with the campus parking maps and where their permit is valid. Keep the following in mind.

1. Most lots during the day require specific permits. Only park in your specified lot or an Any Valid Permit lot.
2. Certain lots open up at night for any valid permit from 5 p.m. to 6 a.m.
3. Break parking takes effect during official university holidays.
